Just a reminder that the Lodge is now open on Fridays at 12 noon. Lunch is served from 12:30 until 4 pm. We are still doing Sunday Lunches from 1 pm. until 6 pm. Come on down and enjoy our fine Chefs fare.

On or about May 12th, we will be adjusting our bar prices. The increases are necessary to keep pace with the rising costs we have experienced.

Typically, Domestic Beer will go to \$2.25 per can/bottle and Buckets will go to \$9.00. Typical Bar drinks will increase .25 cents each. However, Premium and Imported Beers will increase .50 cents each and buckets will be \$12.00 and some Premium Liquors will increase .50 cents.

The House worked several months on the new pricing and it is only with great reluctance we feel it is necessary to implement it, in order to ensure the financial health of the Lodge.


